CONFIDENTIAL INFORMATION. Confidential Information also includes any and all analyses, compilations, products, studies, and other data or material prepared by or in the possession or control of the Intern which contain, include, refer to or otherwise reflect or are generated from any Confidential Information. Confidential Information may be provided in written, oral, electronic, or other form. Intern acknowledges that no representation or warranty, expressed or implied, has been or is made by or on behalf of Sponsor as to the accuracy or completeness of any of the Confidential information furnished to the Intern.

FORM OF DISCLOSURE. Confidential Information may be oral, visual, or by demonstration or in some other form not permanently recorded and shall be considered Confidential Information regardless of whether such Confidential Information has been expressly designated as confidential or proprietary.

PERIOD OF CONFIDENTIALITY AND NON-USE. Intern shall maintain in strict confidence for a period of 10 years from the Effective Date and not disclose any Confidential Information it receives from the Institute to any third party or use the Confidential Information for its own or any other party's benefit, except it is approved for release by written authorization from the Institute

DISCLOSURES REQUIRED BY LAW. In the event Intern is requested or required by a government or court order, or similar process, to disclose any Confidential Information supplied to it by the Institute, Intern shall provide the Institute with prompt notice of such request so that Sponsor may seek an appropriate protective order and/or waive Intern's compliance with the provisions of this Agreement.
